As you recall, we were able to raise over \$30,000 at the inaugural game last summer between Orr and Lake Forest to benefit the Orr basketball program. Frankly, the event and financial support exceeded our wildest dreams. The relationship between the schools continued throughout the year, including our obtaining a comprehensive weight / training room for Orr student athletes. As we spoke about the possibilities, in short order it became clear that a wonderful opportunity was before us. **Net Gain** leaders had quietly dreamed that our initial event might be a springboard for similar city / suburban relationships to develop – and that's what happened. As a result, this year's **Net Gain** will be held on Monday, July 2 beginning at 12:00 noon, featuring New Trier vs. Marshall followed by Lake Forest vs. 2018 AA State Champion Orr. It promises to be a great afternoon of basketball and equally important, a valuable cultural exchange between city and suburban student athletes.
